2. Classes may be combined as entries warrant.
3. All scratches will be charged full fee if scratched without 3-class notification.
4. Refunds per Rule SC-160C
5. All horses must have registration papers (or copy of) presented at Show Office. All Novice Youth/Amateurs and Youth/Amateurs must present their current Amateur/Youth cards at the show office. Cards can be obtained at the Show Office Plus cost and rush fee.
6. Amateur & Youth Ownership Rules AM-020 (1-3), YP-013 (A-B) **NOTE:** Horses owned in Partnership with others than immediate family or lease do not qualify for Youth/Amateur APHA, NWCC or OCC Awards or Points.
7. All Open & Amateur Exhibitors must possess a current APHA membership and All Youth must present a current AjPHA Membership in order to show in APHA-approved classes. To qualify for NWCC Points and High Point Awards exhibitors must be a member of a NWCC Club to be eligible.
